On the whole, I felt that Volf's conclusions remained largely abstract and academic, though valuable; so deeply rooted in history that they are hard to adjust to contemporary trials, though the concepts are timeless.

Theology Slam winner: From exclusion to embrace

The antithesis of exclusion is embrace, Volf's metaphor for forgiveness and reconciliation. We embrace as we make space in ourselves to receive the other, even if the other is an enemy. While he shares much with liberation theology, Volf does not think that the categories of oppression and liberation can carry the weight they need to.

Volf won the 2002 Louisville Grawemeyer Award in Religion for the first edition of his book, Exclusion & Embrace: A Theological Exploration of Identity, Otherness, and Reconciliation (Abingdon, 1996). In that first edition, professor Volf, a Croatian by birth, analyzed the civil war and " ethnic cleansing " in the former Yugoslavia, and he readily found other examples of cultural, ethnic, and racial conflict to illustrate his points.

To completely exclude is to mar oneself. So, this dual aspect calls on the dual work of exclusion and embrace. Only by limited exclusion can there be meaningful distinction between persons, necessary for self-identification. And only by daring embrace can there be impassioned communion between persons, necessary for healing. Invite the excluded, wait, embrace with closed arms, and let go. This is the drama of embrace.
