The Priory of St Mary was moved from Runcorn to Norton in 1134 by William fitz William, third baron of Halton. In the mid-eighteenth century, much of the house was demolished to make way for a fashionable classically inspired mansion, which was occupied until 1921 and finally demolished in 1928.
